Dining Guide

At the Pendry

- **Lion Fish** – Driven by seasonal, local ingredients, the menu features inventive fresh-catch along with prime meats from Chef JoJo Ruiz. Located on the first level of Pendry, private dining space available. Open for dinner nightly, \$\$\$
- **Provisional** – With sky high ceilings, this venue features an open kitchen design, Vittoria espresso bar, grab and go offerings, and a locally inspired mercantile. Located on the first level of Pendry, open for breakfast, lunch and dinner daily, \$\$

American

- **Bankers Hill Restaurant & Bar** (5-10 min drive) – A hidden gem just a short drive from the Gaslamp, tucked away on a quiet street, modern unique space, casual and beautiful at the same time. Dinner nightly, Sunday brunch, 2202 4th Avenue, \$\$
- **Greystone** (5 min walk) – Modern American steakhouse featuring the finest dry aged meats, wagyu specialty cuts, and seafood. This venue also features an extensive wine selection and full craft cocktail bar, open for dinner nightly. 658 5th Avenue, \$\$\$
- **Rustic Root** (2 min walk) – New American cuisine option, casual setting. Original recipe craft cocktails made with fresh local ingredients and rooftop dining in San Diego. Open for dinner nightly 4pm, brunch Sat-Sun at 9am, 535 5th Avenue, \$\$-\$\$

French Inspired

- **Café Chloe** (10 min walk) – An East Village favorite, this French inspired restaurant offers a seasonal menu from Executive Chef Theo Dimitriou, open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. 721 9th Avenue, \$\$
- **Mister A's** (5-10 min drive) – A San Diego establishment, this beautiful penthouse restaurant has sweeping views of downtown, Balboa Park, harbor/ocean, and the airport. Chef Voitzwinkler brings continental cuisine alive with his French influence. Serving lunch Monday-Friday dinner nightly, 2550 5th Avenue \$\$\$
- **Smoking Goat** (10-15 min drive) – French-American bistro from Chef and owner Fred Piehl. A dark seductive farmhouse vibe leads way to an upscale seasonal menu. Open for dinner Tues-Sat. This is a true local neighborhood favorite. 3408 30th Street \$\$

- **Meze Greek Fusion** (1 min walk) – Greek and Mediterranean restaurant that offers excellent small plates, regional specialties, and special dietary need options all in a unique urban ambiance. Open for lunch and dinner daily. 345 6th Avenue, \$\$

- **Asti Ristorante** (6 min walk) – Northern Italian trattoria features homemade pasta, veal, beef and seafood options, open for lunch and dinner daily.

- **Civico 1845** (5-10 min drive) – Italian classics with a modern twist, fresh pasta made daily with locally grown ingredients and an emphasis on natural flavors. Lunch and dinner served daily.
